AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1353  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**and Ziegler**” and substitute “**Ziegler, Lewis, Healey, Holmes, and Odom**”; strike beginning with “establishing” in line 4 down through “fees;” in line 5; in line 6, strike “an unaccompanied” and substitute “a”; and in line 26, strike “13–903,”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, strike beginning with “has” in line 6 down through “in” in line 7 and substitute “**INCLUDES HOMELESS CHILDREN AND YOUTHS, AS DEFINED IN**”; and in line 13, after “State” insert “**OR, AS SPECIFIED IN THE FEDERAL MCKINNEY–VENTO HOMELESS ASSISTANCE ACT, A LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCY LIAISON OR ANY DESIGNATED SCHOOL PERSONNEL**”.

On pages 4 through 6, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 27 on page 4 through line 27 on page 6, inclusive.

On page 10 in line 15, and on page 12 in line 25, in each instance, after “**STATE**” insert “**OR, AS SPECIFIED IN THE FEDERAL MCKINNEY–VENTO HOMELESS ASSISTANCE ACT, A LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCY LIAISON OR ANY DESIGNATED SCHOOL PERSONNEL**”.

On page 7, in line 28, strike “**UNACCOMPANIED**”.

On page 8, in lines 1 and 6, in each instance, after “**THE**” insert “**FEDERAL**”; strike beginning with the second “**A**” in line 5 down through “**BY**” in line 6 and substitute “**AS SPECIFIED IN**”; in line 6, after “**ACT**” insert “**, A LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCY**”.

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LIAISON OR ANY DESIGNATED SCHOOL PERSONNEL"; and in line 15, strike "AN UNACCOMPANIED" and substitute "A".

On page 10, strike beginning with "HAS" in line 6 down through "IN" in line 7 and substitute "INCLUDES HOMELESS CHILDREN AND YOUTHS, AS DEFINED BY".

On page 12, strike beginning with "HAS" in line 14 down through "IN" in line 15 and substitute "INCLUDES HOMELESS CHILDREN AND YOUTHS, AS DEFINED BY"; after line 30, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 1, 2027, the Motor Vehicle Administration shall report to the House Environment and Transportation Committee and the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee on the number and types of fees that the Administration did not impose on homeless individuals under § 16-111.2 of the Transportation Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, through October 1, 2027, as a result of this Act.";

and in line 31, strike "2." and substitute "3".
