AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1357
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Wims” and substitute “Wims, Bagnall, Cullison, Guzzone, Hill, Hutchinson, S. Johnson, Kipke, Martinez, Rosenberg, Ross, Taveras, White Holland, and Woorman”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 8, insert:

“(2) “DIVISION” MEANS THE DIVISION OF CONSUMER PROTECTION OF THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.”;

in line 9, strike “(2)” and substitute “(3)”; in the same line, strike “INTENTIONALLY”; in line 10, after “PRODUCT” insert “THAT SERVES A TECHNICAL OR FUNCTIONAL PURPOSE”; in line 11, strike “(3)” and substitute “(4)”; in the same line, after “A” insert “DISPOSABLE OR REUSABLE”; in line 12, strike “MENSTRUAL BLOOD AND TISSUE” and substitute “MENSTRUATION”; in line 15, strike “A” and substitute “(1) ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1, 2028, A”; in line 17, after “EACH” insert “CONSUMER-FACING”; after line 18, insert

“(2) A MANUFACTURER MAY LIST A PROPRIETARY INGREDIENT OR COMBINATION OF INGREDIENTS BY THEIR COMMON NAME TO PROTECT CONFIDENTIALITY.”;

and strike in their entirety lines 19 through 23, inclusive, and substitute:

“(C) (1) A MANUFACTURER THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000.

(2) THE DIVISION SHALL PAY ALL PENALTIES COLLECTED BY THE DIVISION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE WITH THE INTENT THAT THE PENALTIES BE USED TO FULLY OFFSET ANY COSTS INCURRED BY THE DIVISION IN CONNECTION WITH THE ENFORCEMENT OF THIS SECTION.”.
