AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1532, AS AMENDED

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Environment and Transportation Committee Amendments (HB1532/823929/1), in line 15 of Amendment No. 1, after “customers;” insert “adding energy generated from certain nuclear energy generating stations as a Tier 1 renewable source eligible for inclusion in the renewable energy portfolio standard;”.

On page 4 of the Environment and Transportation Committee Amendments, in line 23 of Amendment No. 1, strike “and”; and after “7-322” insert “, and 7-701(s)(12)”.

On page 5 of the Environment and Transportation Committee Amendments, in line 3 of Amendment No. 1, after “7-510.3(o).” insert “7-701(s)(10) and (11).”; and in line 10, after “7-505(b)(1).” insert “7-701(a).”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 82 of the Environment and Transportation Committee Amendments, after line 24 of Amendment No. 2, insert:

“7-701.

(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

(s) “Tier 1 renewable source” means one or more of the following types of energy sources:

(10) thermal energy from a thermal biomass system; [and]

(11) raw or treated wastewater used as a heat source or sink for a heating or cooling system; AND

(12) POWER GENERATED BY A NUCLEAR ENERGY GENERATING STATION, INCLUDING A SMALL MODULAR REACTOR, CONNECTED WITH THE ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM SERVING THE STATE.”.
