AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1532, AS AMENDED

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2 of the Environment and Transportation Committee Amendments (HB1532/823929/1), in line 11 of Amendment No. 1, after “contract;” insert “establishing the Advanced Nuclear Energy Facility Development Program within the Administration;”.

On page 6 of the Environment and Transportation Committee Amendments, in line 13 of Amendment No. 1, after “Section” insert “9–2018 and”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 91 of the Environment and Transportation Committee Amendments, after line 14 of Amendment No. 2, insert:

“9–2018.

(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) “ADVANCED NUCLEAR ENERGY FACILITY” INCLUDES A SMALL MODULAR NUCLEAR REACTOR.

(3) “PROGRAM” MEANS THE ADVANCED NUCLEAR ENERGY FACILITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.

(B) THERE IS AN ADVANCED NUCLEAR ENERGY FACILITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM WITHIN THE ADMINISTRATION.

(C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT, SITING, AND CONSTRUCTION OF ADVANCED NUCLEAR ENERGY FACILITIES IN THE STATE.

(D) THE PROGRAM SHALL:

(1) PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FOR SMALL MODULAR NUCLEAR REACTOR PROJECTS;

(2) COORDINATE WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY'S ADVANCED REACTOR DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM TO SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT OF ADVANCED NUCLEAR ENERGY FACILITIES IN THE STATE;

(3) IDENTIFY SUITABLE SITES FOR SMALL MODULAR NUCLEAR REACTOR DEPLOYMENT;

(4) SUPPORT PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS IN DEPLOYING ADVANCED NUCLEAR ENERGY FACILITIES; AND

(5) PROVIDE ASSISTANCE IN IDENTIFYING AND OBTAINING ANY FEDERAL GRANTS OR OTHER FEDERAL FUNDING.”.
