AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 669
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**Delegate Pruski**” and substitute “**Delegates Pruski, Behler, Grammer, Guyton, Healey, and Lewis**”; strike in their entirety lines 2 and 3 and substitute “**State Highway Administration – Third-Party Road Improvements – Required Work Schedule**”; and strike beginning with “prohibiting” in line 4 down through “subdivision;” in line 7 and substitute “authorizing the State Highway Administration to require certain nongovernmental applicants for certain permits to submit a schedule for the work to be performed under the permit; requiring a person issued a certain permit to perform the permitted work in accordance with a certain work schedule; authorizing the Administration to revoke a certain permit under certain circumstances; providing that certain permit holders and its sureties are liable for certain damages;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 7, inclusive, and substitute:

“(6) (I) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY REQUIRE A NONGOVERNMENTAL APPLICANT FOR A PERMIT ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION TO SUBMIT, IN A MANNER THAT THE ADMINISTRATION REQUIRES, A SCHEDULE FOR THE WORK TO BE PERFORMED UNDER THE PERMIT.

“(II) A PERSON ISSUED A PERMIT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION WHO IS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A SCHEDULE TO THE ADMINISTRATION UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH:

1. SHALL COMPLETE ALL WORK IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHEDULE OR ANY EXTENSION THE ADMINISTRATION APPROVES; AND

2. IF THE PERSON FAILS TO COMPLETE THE WORK IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHEDULE OR ANY EXTENSION THE ADMINISTRATION APPROVES, IS:

A. SUBJECT TO REVOCATION OF THE PERMIT; AND

B. LIABLE, WITH ITS SURETIES, FOR ALL DAMAGES SUSTAINED BY THE STATE AS A RESULT OF THE FAILURE, INCLUDING ANY COSTS INCURRED BY THE ADMINISTRATION TO COMPLETE THE WORK.

(iii) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTICE TO A PERSON WHOSE PERMIT IS REVOKED UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH.”
