AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 828
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “**Educational Support Member**” and substitute “**Employee of a County Board of Education**”; and strike beginning with “altering” in line 3 down through “member;” in line 5 and substitute “authorizing the Governor to appoint as a member of the State Board of Education an individual who is an employee of a county board of education under certain circumstances;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with “EDUCATIONAL” in line 9 down through “MEMBER,” in line 10 and substitute “**A MEMBER WHO IS AN EMPLOYEE OF A COUNTY BOARD APPOINTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (5) OF THIS SUBSECTION,**”.

On page 3, strike beginning with “SHALL” in line 4 down through “ADOPTS” in line 22 and substitute “**MAY BE AN EMPLOYEE OF A COUNTY BOARD WHO IS NOT THE TEACHER MEMBER APPOINTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION.**”

(II) NOT MORE THAN TWO REGULAR MEMBERS OF THE STATE BOARD MAY BE EMPLOYEES OF A COUNTY BOARD AT ANY GIVEN TIME.

(III) A REGULAR MEMBER WHO IS AN EMPLOYEE OF A COUNTY BOARD MAY NOT BE A COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT;

in line 23, strike “(V)” and substitute “**(IV)**”; in the same line, strike “**THE EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT MEMBER**” and substitute “**A REGULAR MEMBER WHO IS AN EMPLOYEE OF A COUNTY BOARD**”; in line 25, strike “(VI)” and substitute “**(V)**”; in

the same line, strike “**THE EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT MEMBER**” and substitute “**A REGULAR MEMBER WHO IS AN EMPLOYEE OF A COUNTY BOARD WHO IS A CERTIFICATED PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEE UNDER TITLE 6, SUBTITLE 4 OF THIS ARTICLE**”; and after line 27, insert:

“(VI) A REGULAR MEMBER WHO IS AN EMPLOYEE OF A COUNTY BOARD WHO IS A NONCERTIFICATED, NONSUPERVISORY PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEE UNDER TITLE 6, SUBTITLE 5 OF THIS ARTICLE MAY NOT VOTE ON ANY APPEALS TO THE STATE BOARD OF A DISMISSAL OR DISCIPLINARY ACTION OF PERSONNEL UNDER § 4-205 OF THIS ARTICLE.”
