AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 8, after “protocols;” insert “making a violation of this Act an unfair, abusive, or deceptive trade practice under the Maryland Consumer Protection Act;”; after line 12, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
Article – Commercial Law  
Section 13–301(14)(xlvii)  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(2025 Replacement Volume)

BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
Article – Commercial Law  
Section 13–301(14)(xlviii)  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(2025 Replacement Volume)”;

and in line 15, after “Section” insert “13–301(14)(xlix); and”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 21, insert:

“13–301.

Unfair, abusive, or deceptive trade practices include any:

(14) Violation of a provision of:

(xlvii) Title 14, Subtitle 50 of this article; [or]

(xlviii) Section 13-411.1(c)(2) of the Transportation Article; or

On page 2, in line 3, strike "**§ 3.5-801**" and substitute "**§ 15-10B-05.1**"; in line 4, strike "**STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT**" and substitute "**INSURANCE**"; in line 14, after "**PSYCHIATRIST**" insert "**OR OTHER LICENSED PHYSICIAN**"; in line 16, strike "**AND**"; and in line 17, after "**THERAPIST**" insert "**; AND**

(VI) A NURSE PRACTITIONER".

On page 3, strike beginning with "**PERSON**" in line 17 down through "**VIOLATION**" in line 18 and substitute "**VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (A) OR (B) OF THIS SECTION IS:**

(1) AN UNFAIR, ABUSIVE, OR DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE WITHIN THE MEANING OF TITLE 13 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND

(2) SUBJECT TO THE ENFORCEMENT PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN TITLE 13 OF THIS ARTICLE".
