4 FOR the purpose of authorizing ~~Baltimore City to enact and enforce local laws~~ a certain
5 enforcement officer to enforce provisions regulating the sale and distribution of
6 cigarettes, other tobacco products, and electronic smoking devices, ~~subject to certain~~
7 ~~exceptions~~; authorizing the Executive Director of the Alcohol, Tobacco, and Cannabis
8 Commission to reprimand a licensee or suspend or revoke a license for a violation
9 identified under this Act; requiring the Comptroller to distribute a certain amount
10 of the licensure authorization request fees collected under certain provisions of this
11 Act to the Family League of Baltimore City, Inc. in a certain manner; requiring an
12 applicant for a certain initial or renewal license to request a licensure authorization
13 from the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City and pay a certain fee; and
14 generally relating to the regulation of cigarettes, other tobacco products, and
15 electronic smoking devices in Baltimore City.

20 (d) (1) An enforcement officer of the Tobacco Use Prevention and Cessation

 2 of Baltimore City may not issue a licensure authorization under § 16-302.1, § 16.5-201.1,
 3 or § 16.7-201.1 of the Business Regulation Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, for
 4 an initial licensure applicant between October 1, 2026, and October 1, 2027, both inclusive.

5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 6 October 1, 2026.
