AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**Delegate Rosenberg**” and substitute “**Delegates Rosenberg, Alston, Bagnall, Cullison, Guzzone, Hill, Hutchinson, S. Johnson, Kaufman, Kipke, Lopez, Martinez, M. Morgan, Reilly, Ross, Szeliga, Taveras, White Holland, and Woorman**”; in line 3, after “altering” insert “, under certain circumstances,”; and after line 10, insert:

(2023 Replacement Volume and 2025 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 15, strike “Within” and substitute “**EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION, WITHIN**”; in the same line, strike the brackets; and in the same line, strike “**12**”.

On page 2, in line 3, strike “The” and substitute “**EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION, THE**”; in line 5, strike the brackets; in the same line, strike “**12**”; in line 6, strike “Within” and substitute “**EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION, WITHIN**”; in the same line, strike the brackets; in the same line, strike “**12**”; in line 22, strike “The” and substitute “**EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION, THE**”; in the same line, strike the brackets; in the same line, strike “**12**”; and after line 23, insert:

“(G) A CERTIFICATE OF BIRTH MAY BE FILED WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER THE BIRTH OCCURRED IF A PARENT OF THE CHILD NOTIFIES THE DIVISION OF VITAL RECORDS IN A MANNER REQUIRED BY THE SECRETARY AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE AFTER BIRTH, BUT NOT LATER THAN 5 DAYS AFTER THE BIRTH OCCURS.”.
