A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Local Boards of Elections – Board Counsel – Qualifications**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the qualifications for counsel to local boards of elections; and
4 generally relating to local boards of elections.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Election Law**

18 2–201.

19 (a) (1) There is a county board of elections in each county of the State.

20 2–205.

21 (a) Each local board may appoint or retain as counsel an individual who is:

- 1 (1) a registered voter of [its county] **THE STATE**; and
- 2 (2) admitted to practice law in the State.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
4 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has
5 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to
6 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
7 enacted.
