AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 627
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “**Day**” and substitute “**and Italian American Days**”; in line 3, strike “a”; in the same line, strike “day” and substitute “days”; in lines 4 and 5, in each instance, strike “Day” and substitute “and Italian American days”; in line 8, strike “7-421” and substitute “7-416 and 7-417 through 7-421”; in line 9, strike “7-422” and substitute “7-417 and 7-419 through 7-423”; in line 14, after “7-401” insert “and 7-418”; in line 18, strike “7-421” and substitute “7-416 and 7-417 through 7-421”; and in line 19, strike “7-422” and substitute “7-417 and 7-419 through 7-423”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 7, insert:

“7-418.

(A) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM OCTOBER 1 AS ITALIAN AMERICAN DAY.

(B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE ITALIAN AMERICAN DAY PROPERLY WITH APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.”.
