AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 789
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “**Vehicle Laws – Automotive Repair Facilities**” and substitute “**Motor Vehicle Administration**”; in line 3, after “**Systems**” insert “**Repairs – Study**”; strike beginning with “certain” in line 4 down through “facilities” in line 13 and substitute “the Motor Vehicle Administration to study and report on the repair and training requirements of advanced driver assistance systems; and generally relating to the repair and training requirements of advanced driver assistance systems”.

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 14 on page 1 through line 6 on page 2, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 8, strike “the Laws of Maryland read as follows”; and after line 8, insert:

“(a) The Motor Vehicle Administration shall study the repair of advanced driver assistance systems and make recommendations on the feasibility of legislation related to the repair of advanced driver assistance systems and training requirements for advanced driver assistance systems.

(b) The study shall include research on:

(1) existing Maryland statutes and regulations on the repair of advanced driver assistance systems;

(2) existing laws and regulations in other states on advanced driver assistance systems;

(3) training requirements for advanced driver assistance systems; and

(4) statistics on accidents related to advanced driver assistance systems.

(c) In conducting the study required under subsection (a) of this section, the Administration shall consult with representatives from:

(1) the Maryland Insurance Administration;

(2) the Maryland Automobile Dealers Association;

(3) the American Automobile Association;

(4) the property and casualty insurance industry;

(5) a national highway safety organization;

(6) a glass repair company;

(7) an automobile body shop trade association;

(8) an advanced driver assistance training company;

(9) an advanced driver assistance manufacturing company; and

(10) an advanced driver assistance systems parts company.

(d) On or before January 1, 2027, the Administration shall report its findings and recommendations to the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee and the House

Economic Matters Committee, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article.”.

On pages 2 through 10, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 9 on page 2 through line 16 on page 10, inclusive.

On page 10, in line 18, strike “October” and substitute “June”.
