AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 791, AS AMENDED

On page 2 of the Judiciary Committee Amendments (SB791/583829/1), after line 7 of Amendment No. 3, insert:

“SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before April 1, 2028, the Governor’s Office of Crime Prevention and Policy shall report to the Legislative Policy Committee, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, on the number of immigrants without legal residency status in the United States who have been convicted of a crime in the State and sentenced to a term of imprisonment of at least 10 years since the taking effect of this Act.”;

in line 8, strike “3.” and substitute “4.”; and in line 12, after “enacted.” insert “It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years from the date it is enacted and, at the end of the 2-year period, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.
