A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Dorchester County – Alcoholic Beverages – Issuance of License Near a Place of**
3 **Worship or School**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Dorchester County
5 to issue an alcoholic beverages license to an establishment that is within a certain
6 distance of a place of worship or school with the written consent of the place of
7 worship or school; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in
8 Dorchester County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis**

22 19–102.

23 This title applies only in Dorchester County.

1 (a) (1) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Board may not
2 issue a new license for an establishment that is within 300 feet in a direct line of a place of
3 worship or a public or nonpublic kindergarten, elementary, or secondary school.

4 (2) The distance from the establishment to the place of worship or the
5 public or nonpublic kindergarten, elementary, or secondary school is to be measured from
6 the establishment in a direct line to the nearest point of the main building of the place of
7 worship or school.

8 (b) The prohibition against issuing a license in subsection (a) of this section does
9 not apply to the issuance of:

10 (1) a license for a premises that was licensed on October 1, 1996;

11 (2) a Class B (on-sale) beer, wine, and liquor license for a premises in
12 Cambridge, Secretary, or Hurlock; [or]

13 (3) a temporary license; **OR**

14 **(4) A LICENSE IF THE BOARD RECEIVES WRITTEN CONSENT TO THE**
15 **ISSUANCE OF THE LICENSE FROM EACH PLACE OF WORSHIP OR SCHOOL LOCATED**
16 **WITHIN 300 FEET IN A DIRECT LINE OF THE ESTABLISHMENT FOR WHICH THE**
17 **LICENSE IS SOUGHT.**

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
19 1, 2025.
