### CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages – Barbershop and Beauty Salon**  
3 **License**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a holder of a barbershop and beauty salon license in Anne  
5 Arundel County to provide a certain amount of liquor for on–premises consumption  
6 in addition to beer and wine; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses  
7 in Anne Arundel County.

1 Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis  
 2 Section 11–1002  
 3 Annotated Code of Maryland

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
 6 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

7 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis**

8 11–102.

9 This title applies only in Anne Arundel County.

10 11–1002.

11 (a) There is a barbershop and beauty salon beer [and], wine, **AND LIQUOR**  
 12 license.

13 (b) The Board may issue the license to a holder of:

14 (1) a barbershop permit issued under § 4–501 of the Business Occupations  
 15 and Professions Article; or

16 (2) a beauty salon permit issued under § 5–501 of the Business Occupations  
 17 and Professions Article.

18 (c) The license authorizes the license holder to provide **TO A CUSTOMER DURING**  
 19 **ANY ONE VISIT** not more than 12 ounces of beer [or], 5 ounces of wine by the glass, **OR 1.7**  
 20 **OUNCES OF LIQUOR** for on–premises consumption by ~~a~~ **THE** barbershop or beauty salon  
 21 customer:

22 (1) when the customer is being provided:

23 (i) a barbering service under Title 4 of the Business Occupations  
 24 and Professions Article; or

25 (ii) a cosmetology service under Title 5 of the Business Occupations  
 26 and Professions Article; or

27 (2) while the customer is attending a fund–raising event at the barbershop  
 28 or beauty salon.

29 (d) A license holder may serve beer [and], wine, **AND LIQUOR** for on–premises  
 30 consumption during normal business hours but not later than 9 p.m.

1 (e) A license holder need not obtain a Sunday license under § 11–2004 of this title  
2 to provide beer [and], wine, **AND LIQUOR** on Sunday.

3 (f) The annual license fee is \$100.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
5 1, 2026.
